CIB OF AGC

Central Illinois Builders of the Associated General Contractors of America (CIB of AGC) is an association of union builders dedicated to improving professional standards of the construction industry along with the skill, integrity, and responsibility of its member firms.

CIB-AGC has a 21-member board of directors elected by membership at the annual meeting of the association. Between board meetings, the executive committee of CIB (composed of the president, two vice presidents, secretary/treasurer, associate contractor delegate, and immediate past president) direct the affairs of the association and report to the board.

The chapter staff administer the policy and direction determined by the board and executive committee. The chapter office is located in Springfield a block away from the state capitol building. CIB is represented at the national AGC by two national directors.

WHO CAN JOIN

Any firm that has its livelihood wholly or in part derived from the construction industry may be a member of CIB, which has three classes of members:

Active Members

General contractors and construction managers who are engaged in public and/or private sector construction projects.

An entrance fee of \$100 must accompany each application for membership. Dues are based on volume from the prior year and billed annually in January. Those dues paid to CIB include AGC of America membership.

Prior year annual volume **LESS**
than \$10 million = \$1,000

Prior year annual volume **MORE**
than \$10 million = \$2,600

These dues provide CIB of AGC and AGC of America membership for the year.

Associate Members

An individual or firm employing job site labor but not responsible for overall project coordination.

An entrance fee of \$100 must accompany each application for membership. Annual dues are \$660, billed annually in January for CIB of AGC and AGC of America membership.

Affiliate Members

Individuals or firms in associated industries qualify if aligned with construction and have a material interest in the welfare of the industry and this association.

An entrance fee of \$100 must accompany each application for membership. Annual dues are \$400, billed annually in January for CIB of AGC and AGC of America membership.

All memberships that begin in a month other than January will have dues prorated by month.

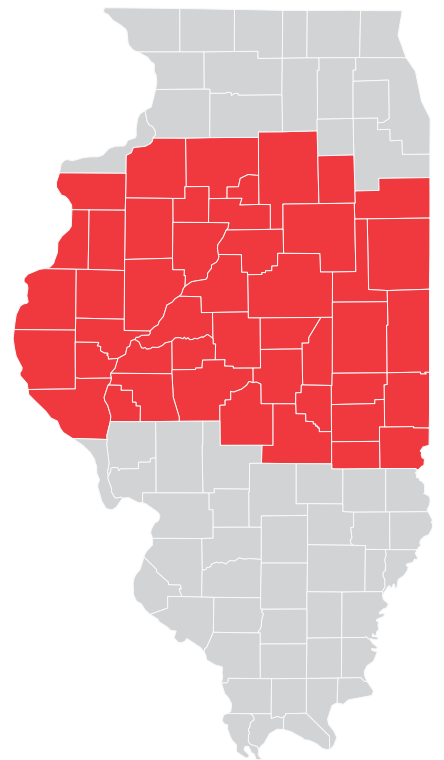
